READING PROGRAM

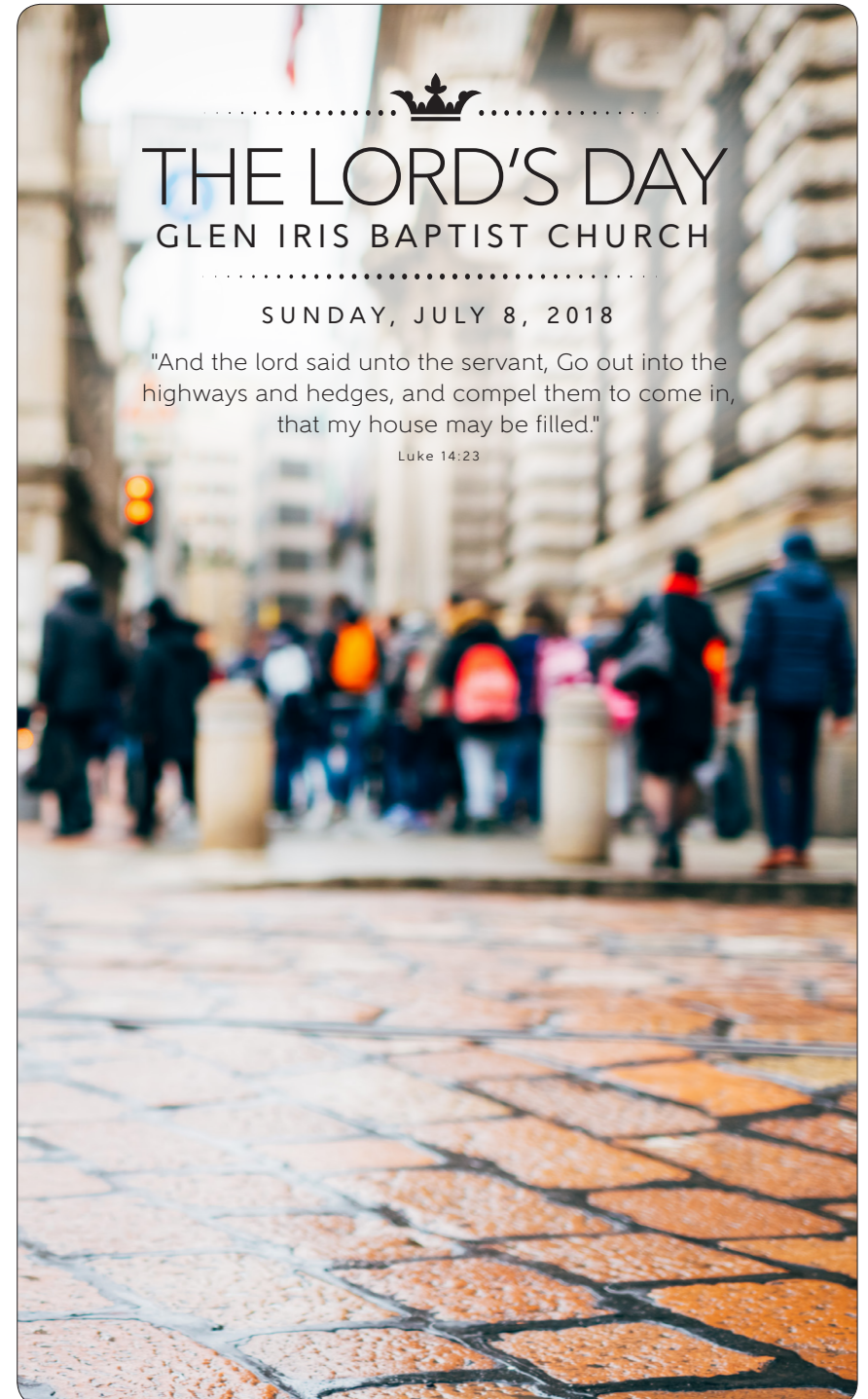
