PSALM 145:19



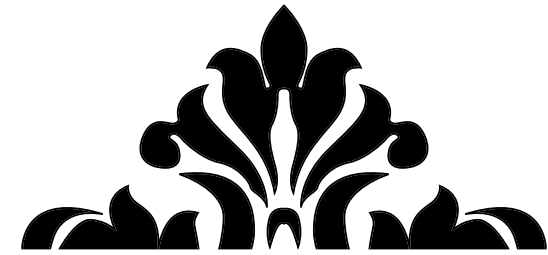

They desire supplies for their need, help under burdens, guidance in perplexity, deliverance in distress. Sometimes this desire is so strong, and their case so pressing, that they cry out in agony, like little children in pain. Then the Lord works most comprehensively and does all that is needful, according to this word, "and will save them."

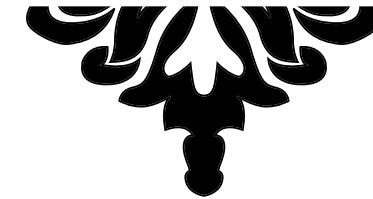
Yes, if we fear God, we have nothing else to fear; if we cry to the Lord, our salvation is certain.
