

Life Groups: Connecting people to God, His Word, and One Another

Questions based upon Christian's message on May 13.

CONNECTING PEOPLE TO ONE ANOTHER:

- 1) We just celebrated Mother's Day on Sunday. Give us three words that describe your mom. What is one thing you would praise your mom for?
- 2) Since we talked about death last Sunday, what is the oddest thing you've seen happen at a funeral?

CONNECTING PEOPLE TO GOD'S WORD: Read John 11:25-27

- 1) Who did Jesus claim to be in verse 25?
- 2) What did Jesus say would happen to those who believe in him?
- 3) What does this verse reveal to us about eternal life?
- 4) Why does Martha's response represent a high point in John's gospel?

CONNECTING PEOPLE TO GOD THOROUGH THE SERMON AND PRAYER:

- 1) Why is death scary?
- 2) What is the truth about death?
- 3) How do you know that death is defeated? What makes you believe in eternal life?
- 4) Christian said the bottom line is that Jesus doesn't make us alive to live like we're dead. What does that mean to you?
- 5) What else did you write down in your notes? What was God speaking to your heart during the message?

APPLYING THIS LESSON:

- 1) How can you share this good news with others? How are you doing at sharing your faith and inviting people to connect with God?
