- Week 1** **Lesson 101 – What is the Bible?**
1 Thessalonians 2:13 And we also thank God constantly for this, that when you received the word of God, which you heard from us, you accepted it not as the word of men but as what it really is, the word of God, which is at work in you believers.
- Week 2** **Lessons 102 and 103 – How can we know that the Bible is really the true Word of God?**
1 Corinthians 2:12 Now we have received not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that we might understand the things freely given us by God.
- Week 3** **Lesson 104 – Does God’s Word teach any lies?**
Psalms 119:160 The sum of Your word is truth, and every one of Your righteous rules endures forever.
- Week 4** **Lesson 106 – Is God’s Word still good and true for us today?**
Matthew 5:18 For truly, I say to you, until heaven and earth pass away, not an iota, not a dot, will pass from the Law until all is accomplished.
- Week 5** **Lesson 109 – Does God’s Word have authority over people?**
2 Timothy 3:16 All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness.
- Week 6** **Lesson 201 – Does the Lord say He is greater than we are?**
Isaiah 55:9 For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are My ways higher than your ways and My thoughts than your thoughts.
- Week 7** **Lesson 203 – Did God ever have a beginning?**
Revelation 1:8 “I am the Alpha and the Omega,” says the Lord God, “who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty.”
- Week 8** **Lesson 204 – Does God ever change or get tired?**
Malachi 3:6 “For I the Lord do not change; therefore you, O children of Jacob, are not consumed.
- Week 9** **Lesson 206 – How powerful is God?**
Jeremiah 32:17 Ah, Lord God! It is You who have made the heavens and the earth by Your great power and by Your outstretched arm! Nothing is too hard for You.

- Week 10** **Lesson 207 and 208 – What does God know?**
1 John 3:19-20 By this we shall know that we are of the truth and reassure our heart before Him; for whenever our heart condemns us, God is greater than our heart, and He knows everything.
- Week 11** **Lesson 302 – Who gives us all good things?**
Psalm 84:11 For the Lord God is a sun and shield; the Lord bestows favor and honor. No good thing does He withhold from those who walk uprightly.
- Week 12** **Lesson 303 and 304 – How good is God?**
Isaiah 6:3 And one called to another and said: “Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of hosts; the whole earth is full of His glory!”
- Week 13** **Lesson 307 – Would God rather punish or forgive?**
Lamentations 3:22-23 The steadfast love of the Lord never ceases; His mercies never come to an end; they are new every morning; great is Your faithfulness.
- Week 14** **Lesson 309 – Does God pretend not to see when we sin?**
Romans 1:18-19 For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who by their unrighteousness suppress the truth. ¹⁹For what can be known about God is plain to them, because God has shown it to them.
- Week 15** **Lesson 310 – How can you please God who is perfectly good?**
Deuteronomy 13:4 You shall walk after the Lord your God and fear Him and keep His commandments and obey His voice, and you shall serve Him and hold fast to Him.
- Week 16** **Lesson 401 – Is there anyone like God?**
Jeremiah 10:6-7 There is none like you, O Lord; You are great, and Your name is great in might. ⁷Who would not fear You, O King of the nations? For this is Your due; for among all the wise ones of the nations and in all their kingdoms there is none like You.
- Week 17** **Lesson 404 – Does the Bible teach that there is only one true God?**
Deuteronomy 6:4 Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one.
- Week 18** **Lesson 405 – Who are the three persons of the Trinity?**
Matthew 28:19-20 Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age.

- Week 19** **Lesson 407, 408, and 409 – Does the Bible teach that the Father, Son (Jesus Christ) and Holy Spirit is God?**
Isaiah 48:16 Draw near to me, hear this; from the beginning I have not spoken in secret, from the time it came to be I have been there.” And now the Lord God has sent me and his Spirit.
- Week 20** **Lesson 501, 504, and 505 – What is creationism?**
Genesis 1:1-2 In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth. ²The earth was without form and void, and darkness was over the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters.
- Week 21** **Lesson 507 – How can we really know for sure that everything was created by God and what does that creation show us?**
Hebrews 11:3 By faith we understand that the universe was created by the word of God, so that what is seen was not made out of things that are visible.
- Week 22** **Lesson 510 – How should learning the truth about creation change the way you think about God the creator?**
Romans 14:11-12 For it is written, “As I live, says the Lord, every knee shall bow to me, and every tongue shall confess to God.” So then each of us will give an account of himself to God.
- Week 23** **Lesson 601, 602, and 603 – How did human beings get here?**
Genesis 2:7 then the Lord God formed the man of dust from the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life, and the man became a living creature.
- Week 24** **Lesson 604 – What did God create you to do?**
Psalms 86:11-12 Teach me Your way, O Lord, that I may walk in Your truth; unite my heart to fear Your name. ¹²I give thanks to You, O Lord my God, with my whole heart, and I will glorify Your name forever.
- Week 25** **Lesson 608 – What happened after the first sin? (The Fall)**
1 Corinthians 15:21-22 For as by a man came death, by a man has come also the resurrection of the dead. ²²For as in Adam all die, so also in Christ shall all be made alive.
- Week 26** **Lesson 609 – Does God leave all sinners to die in their sin, guilt, and misery?**
John 3:16-18 For God so loved the world, that He gave His only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life. ¹⁷For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through Him. ¹⁸Whoever believes in Him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe is condemned already, because He has not believed in the name of the only Son of God.
