Leading Your Children To Faith  
Ephesians 6:1-4

1. What are some of the threats to the faith of our children? What is the greatest threat?
2. How is a faulty view of sin a barrier in leading your children to faith?
3. How is a faulty view of salvation a barrier in leading your children to faith?
4. Does a sincere belief in the facts of the Bible save a person? If not, what is missing according to James 2:19-20? See also the examples of the Rich Young Ruler in Mark 10 and those who "believed" in John 2.
5. How can we help our children understand that it's important to repent from sin (not just say "I believe") and to allow them to see the work of God in their life over time?
6. What type of commitment to Christ do we see in Philippians 3:8-9? What are some practical ways we can live this out in front of our children? What should this type of commitment look like in the lives of our children?
