1. What are the two main commands for children given in verses 1-2? How can we as parents help them with these commands?
2. What is the danger of just parenting actions verses "obedience in the Lord"? How is this 'the heart of the matter'?
3. There are many things that fathers and parents in general can do to lead their children to anger. Which of these 4 do you struggle with the most and what will you do to correct it? Being unreasonable, faultfinding, neglect or inconsistency. (no you can't pick all of them, let's be reasonable 8).
4. What qualities did Nabal's wife demonstrate in 1 Samuel 25:23-28 and why was her request honored by David?
5. Sometimes parents think it is our job to save our children. What is our role in their salvation and how does Romans 1:16 clarify this issue for us?
6. Which one of these 3 action steps will you work to apply today?
 - a. Get your own spiritual walk in order
 - b. Develop a greater trust in God's sovereignty
 - c. Give your child room to grow and think through their own faith and actions.
