4. Why do you think they spelled out their financial commitments as they supported the house of God? Why is it important for us to support the church financially? (34-37) (Please don't leave goats or cows at the church office!) 8)
5. Does our support of GBC give God a good name in the community? Are there any areas of our church that need more support? If so, what can we do about this?
