2. What reason does James give for us to be “slow to speak, slow to anger?” How should this motivate us?
3. How do verses 18 & 20 relate to each other?
4. What do “filthiness and rampant wickedness” mean? In what areas might we need to address this in our own lives?
5. How does the word of God come into play when dealing with anger? (v. 21)
6. What does it mean that God’s word is “able to save your souls” since James is talking to believers? (v. 21)
7. How has this passage on anger effected your life?
