Job Title: Campus Intern

Job Description:

The Campus Internship Position is designed to provide the intern with an introduction to some of the roles and responsibilities required for full-time campus ministers with Every Nation Campus (ENC). He/she will take a leadership role with ENC at Oregon State University and provide input, strategy, and vision for the organization. The intern will gain competency in applying the "4 E's" (Engage, Establish, Equip, and Empower) toward making disciples. In addition to responsibilities with ENC, the intern will be exposed to many of the day-to-day functions at Grace City Church. Although the intern is certainly not required to enter vocational ministry upon completion of the internship, the internship is designed for those who are at least considering the possibility of vocational ministry in the future.

Time Commitment: 10-15 hours per week for the 2018-19 academic year at Oregon State University

Supervisor: Every Nation Campus (ENC) Director at Oregon State University

Expectations:

- Attend weekly ENC staff meeting
- Attend bimonthly Grace City Church all-staff meeting
- Attend biannual northwest regional Every Nation staff meeting
- Attend weekly ENC campus meeting
- Lead at least one *God Talk*
- Attend all major ENC sponsored events
- Volunteer at the evening church service at Grace City Church
- Attend an Ekklesia (i.e. a church-based small group) and be actively involved in church-related events
- Meet with the ENC Director for biweekly check-in

Qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree or actively working toward completion of degree
- Demonstrates competency in making disciples by: 1) using *The God Test* for relational evangelism, 2) developing Christian student leaders through a *God Talk* small group, and 3) directing students toward Grace City events, courses, and materials such as the *One2One*, *Transformations*, and *Grace City University (GCU)*
- Excellent organizational and communication skills
- Demonstrates strong Christian character (according to Galatians 5:16-25), a growing, vibrant relationship with Jesus Christ, and a love for students at Oregon State University
