### ADULT CHOIRS and ENSEMBLES

**Grace Chorale** sings primarily at the 10:45am sanctuary service each week as well as at special services throughout the year. This choir is open to singers high school age and up. It rehearses each Thursday at 7:15pm in the music room.

**Festival Choir.** This is a limited commitment choir which will sing 1-2 times each year for special occasions such as the Christmas Cantata, Easter, and Patriotic Sunday. Rehearsals for each event will generally begin a minimum of 8 weeks prior to the event.

**Summer Choir.** This choir will sing during the normal off season of the regular adult choir, generally July and August.

**Trinity Bells** handbell choir generally plays once a month throughout the year including festival Sundays. The ensemble consists of a four octave handbell set. Rehearsals are each Thursday at 6:00pm in the balcony.

**Brass Ensemble.** We occasionally utilize a brass ensemble in our services. If you play trumpet, trombone, French horn, baritone or tuba, or any other instrument, please contact Wynn Bonner, x264 to learn more about this opportunity.

**Choir Accompanists** are needed for both adult and children's choirs. If you have good piano skills and desire to be a valuable support to this ministry please contact Wynn Bonner x264.

### CHILDREN'S CHOIR

**Kidz Choir** is open to grades 1-5 and sings in worship on a monthly basis throughout the school year. Rehearsals are Thursdays 3-4pm in the music room. Mr. Micah Korb, director at x285.

### CONTEMPORARY WORSHIP TEAM

**Vocal Worship Team** sings at the 8:30am praise service each Sunday. The music of this worship time consists of some of the most current worship music available. Openings are available through auditioning.

**Worship Band** plays at the 8:30am praise service as the accompaniment to the Vocal Worship Teams and rehearses each week with the vocal teams on Tuesdays beginning at 7:15pm. Openings are available through auditioning.

### WORSHIP SUPPORT

**Audio Engineers** control audio levels in the services. Some experience is preferred although training will be provided.

**Radio Broadcast hosts** record and transmit our 10:45am worship service to WLKF for broadcasting at 11:00am. Radio hosts speak scripted information to the radio listeners and control the sound levels for recording and transmission.

**Multi-media for Worship Projection.** Create computer graphics to enhance worship at the 8:30am praise service. And/or, run computer projection for the praise service.

**Other Worship Support.** Ushers, greeters, altar guild (communion set-up), scripture readers are always needed. Contact the church office.

**Fine Arts School of Central Florida.** This school of the arts is an endeavor at Grace to provide opportunities for equipping students, both young and older, in the arts, including music (vocal/instrumental), dance, crafts, drawing, etc. It is desired that these students will one day be able to use their gifts for God's glory in worship.
