NEW DRINKING FOUNTAINS!

New drinking fountains will be installed on the first and second floors over Christmas break. The new fountains will have a chiller (no more students sneaking into the back of the church for cold water) and the second floor will also have a water bottle filler.

This improvement to the school was made possible by funds raised at the School Auction last spring.

RECESS AND COLD WEATHER

Recess is an important part of the overall school environment. As a staff we have observed that fresh air and being outdoors is good for children. Therefore, we will do all that we can to have your child spend at least some time each day outside.

The only times we won't go outside are: if it's raining, lightning, colder than 20 degrees Fahrenheit, or if the wind chill is below 20.

This means that you should expect your child will go outside for recess. It means that your child should be dressed and prepared to play outside! Coats, hats, mittens or gloves are in order.

If your child has a condition, such as sickle cell anemia and provides a doctor's note that requires the child to stay inside--please make the teacher aware. In most other cases, if a child is too sick to go outside, then the child should probably not be in school.

~~All Tuition payments must be up-to-date by the end of each month of school. ***Students with outstanding tuition MAY NOT attend class on the first Monday of the new month.*** 50% of the outstanding tuition must be paid before the student may attend class. Payment may be made by cash, credit/debit card, or money order. Personal checks will not be accepted.
