

Grace Group Questions

10-07-2018 – John 14:7-14 – Jesus Reveals God

REMINDER: The purpose of our Grace Groups is to help our church family mature in our love for the Lord and each other. We seek to do this by 1. Practical Sermon Application 2. Practicing the One Another's 3. Providing Care 4. Praying Together 5. Pursuing Discipleship. These questions are simply a tool to help you achieve these purposes. You will notice that these questions are structured according to the three basic principles of Bible study - observation, interpretation, and application.

1. Sermon Passage: Read John 14:7-14

- What was the main point of Sunday's sermon?
- Can you outline the sermon?

2. Observation – What did you hear?

- In vv. 7-11 how many times does Jesus declare that He and the Father are one in essence and function? Why is this important?
- John 1:18 says, "No one has ever seen God; the only God, who is at the Father's side, he has made him known." Read Col. 1:15; 1 Tim. 1:17; Ex. 33:20; Deut. 5:26; Judges 13:22; John 5:37, 6:46; 1 Tim. 6:16. How do these verses contribute to your understanding of John 1:18?
- What are the two 'sign posts' that reveal the wonder of Christ's character? Cf 14:11

3. Interpretation – What does it mean?

- Read Colossians 1:15, 19 and Hebrews 1:3. How do these verses develop the theme of Jesus perfectly revealing God?
- Enumerate some of the word and works of Christ that reveal His deity.

4. Application – How does this apply?

- What specific words and/or works of Christ have made the biggest impression on you personally?
- When you are troubled by events and circumstances, what is it that should bring you the greatest peace and confidence?
- Many in the church today are like Philip who desired a physical, tangible manifestation of God. Why do you think people of all generations have looked for signs from God? How would you address a friend who is hungry for miraculous signs?
