Word & Deed Project Update: Nakekela Clinic (South Africa)
At the Nakekela Clinic an average of ten new patients are admitted per month; some of them stay for many weeks. This means that all 20 in-patient beds are full most of the time. In addition to the in-patient care for critical cases, the Nakekela Home Based Care team makes almost 100 house calls per month. At each visit, workers pray with and for patients. Because of the difficult nature of the work (about 40% of patients die) and the dedication the staff has in taking care of patients, they covet your prayers to help them cope with the sorrow and burdens they carry for their patients.
