LEARN

What stood out to you from the sermon on Sunday? What was most helpful, encouraging or challenging to your walk with Christ?

Read Colossians 1:17, Job 12:10, and Hebrews 11:1-3. Why is it important to believe the biblical teaching that the universe is not God or any part of God, but distinct from God?

When does science go beyond the realm of observation into philosophy or religious belief? How can we appreciate scientific understanding while being mindful of what science cannot answer for us?

PRACTICE

As a Christian, what are the most important things you need to assert about creation from the Bible? What kinds of things do you need to hold more loosely and humbly, where the Bible does not give every answer?

Read Psalm 104:27-35. How can someone develop a more observant, worshipful response to God's works and glory revealed in creation? Why is it important that we do so?

In our sin, we shrink God down and make much of ourselves. How can the doctrine of creation help you repent quickly, worship gladly, and live daily for God's glory?

CHANGE

What is a specific way you have shrunk God in your own life? Where do you need to repent and seek God's power to change you so that you view him, and therefore yourself, rightly?
