## **LEARN**

Read Galatians 3:25 – 4:7 together. What stands out to you in the text and from Sunday's sermon?

What is the importance of Paul saying Christians have "put on Christ" in 3:27?

How should we understand the term "When the fullness of time had come" in 4:4?

## **PRACTICE**

What impact does being "a son of God through faith" have on your life? Or, what impact should it have on a daily basis when you consider it as your deepest, truest identity?

Galatians 3:28 would have been a game changer for those who first heard it. How should it shape the way we think of, behave toward, and love one another in the church?

Read Galatians 4:6-7 again. Notice the absolute, no-doubt-about-it, truths of "you are" and "has sent" and "if a son, then an heir". How do you respond at the heart level to these truths? In what ways do you struggle to believe this about yourself?

## **CHANGE**

"Abba Father" is an incredibly intimate expression. It is our right as sons to approach the holy God of the universe in this way. Do you approach God in prayer with this kind of intimacy? How can you develop that?
