

Breakout Facilitator

This would be a man or woman who possess particular giftedness in helping people be transparent, sharing from the heart during the men's and women's breakout times of group. They are in charge of determining the topic to discuss, or the question to ask, or how to follow up on previous commitments someone made.

The Breakout Facilitator:

- Prepares ahead of small group to determine what the focus of the Breakout time will be. This may mean using the "Change" question provided on Small Group Questions, or something else from the sermon, or even something from their own Scripture reading they want to bring before the group.
- Is open with his or her life in a way that models it for others. He or she needs to be willing to go first and go most often when it comes to transparent sharing from the heart about struggles, sins, worries, etc. that promote depth in a group
- Asks people to share their testimony after they've become part of the small group. He or she has some awareness of who has not shared their life story yet and asks them to do so for the sake of the entire group
- Strives to develop accountability within the group when commitments are made.
