2 Simple but important lessons from 1 Samuel 13:

1. Obedience to God is the non-negotiable expression of faith (aka "trust").

Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths. Be not wise in your own eyes; fear the LORD, and turn away from evil. It will be healing to your flesh and refreshment to your bones. - Proverbs 3:5-8

2. God is to be obeyed, and He teaches us that Jesus is Lord.
