REVELATION LEADS TO ADORATION

Luke 24:13-35

In order to worship Jesus through Bible reading, we must see that every single text of the Bible points to Jesus, from Genesis to Revelation.

In order to worship Jesus through Bible reading, we must pray that God would reveal more of Jesus through our reading!

When God reveals more of Jesus to us through the Bible by the power of the Holy Spirit, we will respond with adoration!

Digging Deeper into the Message

Read Ephesians 1:15-23

What does the writer pray that God will give to the Ephesians in verses 17?

What does that mean, in your own words?

What 3 things does he want them/us to know (verses 18-19)?

What accomplishes this? (end of verse 20)

Where is Jesus now? List all the words and phrases that describe where he is now, from verses 20-23. (there are at least 6!)

How can you apply this to your life this week?

ICEBREAKER: What prayer have you been praying the longest?

QUESTIONS:

- ❖ Read the first two points on the MAP.
- ❖ Where have you seen Jesus in your New Testament readings? What about your Old Testament readings? (you can still answer this, even if you're not reading through the bible reading plan that Harvest is doing.)
- ❖ Do you ever have a hard time reading because you just don't want to read the Bible or find it boring? Have you ever tried praying and asking God to give you more enjoyment in the scriptures? How did he answer your prayer?
- ❖ Summarize the I.O.U.S.L. prayer outline that Pastor Scott talked about. Have you found this to be helpful? Bonus points: look up and read each passage!
 - **Incline** my heart to your testimonies (Ps. 119:36);
 - **Open** my eyes to your word (Ps. 119:18);
 - **Unite** my heart to fear your name (Ps. 86:11);
 - **Satisfy** me in the morning with your love (Ps. 90:14);
 - **Lead** me in the paths of love and righteousness (Ps. 23:3)
- ❖ Read the last point on the MAP.
- ❖ What does adoration mean?
- ❖ Is there anything else you want to talk about?

Application: Reading the Bible is not the way to make God happy with you (Heb. 6). But reading it will bring more joy and peace to your life (Ps. 119). So keep at it! If you haven't started yet, why not start today? 😊
