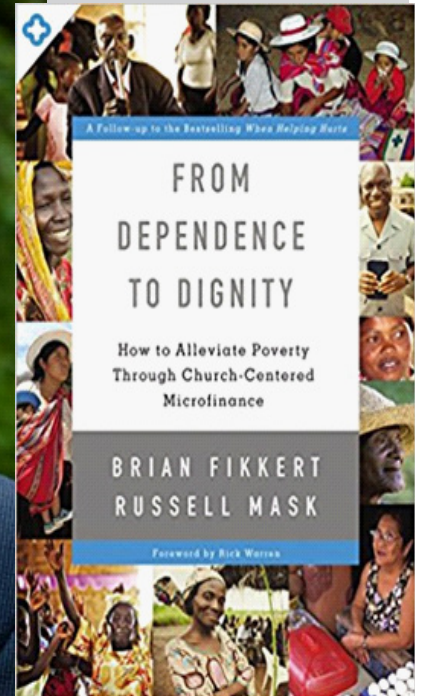
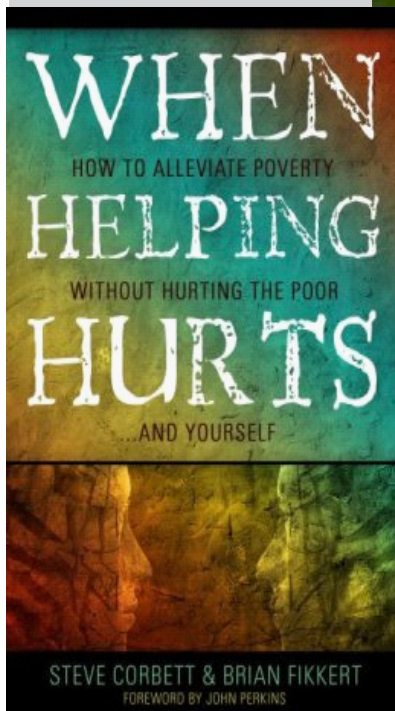

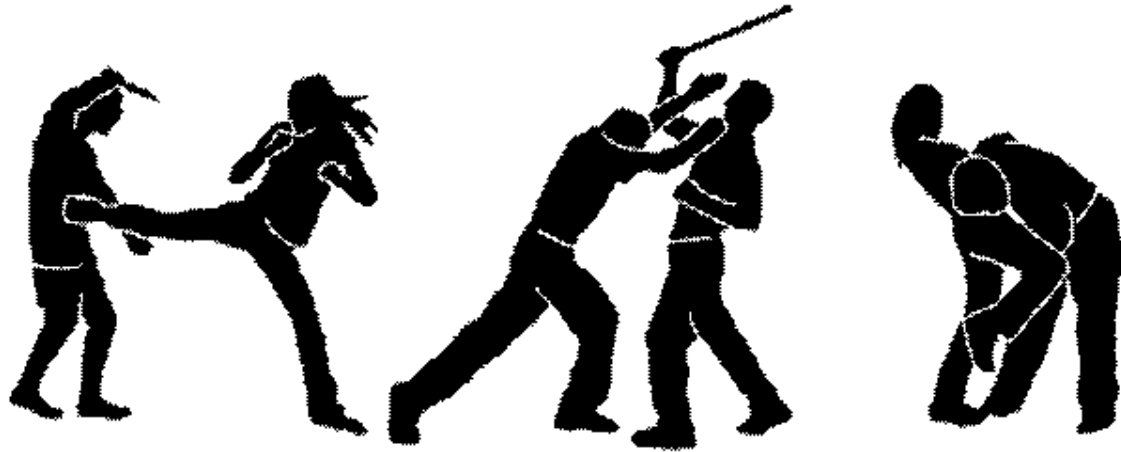
## HPC'S Annual Global Outreach Conference
