Several members of the mission committee have fulfilled their three year commitment and are rotating off the committee.

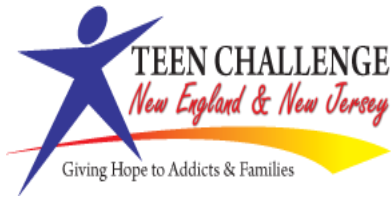
