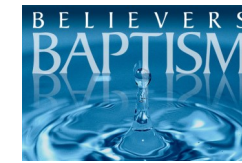
ECUMENICAL GOOD FRIDAY SERVICE THE WAY OF THE CROSS Procession of the Cross

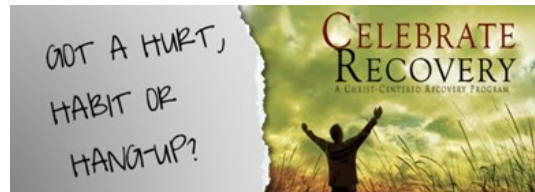
See Below How You Can Worship from 11:30-12:15pm
