

Becoming an EZ Worship Operator

Purpose: The purpose of this document is to give you (the prospective EZ Worship Operator) a clear understanding of the process through which you become an active operator.

Process:

Step 1.) The first step in this process is to express your interest to an elder or worship team leader. They will direct you to our website which contains a brief description of our worship ministry's distinctives and a questionnaire for you to fill out as well as the documents titled *"EZ Worship Operator Criteria and Guidelines," "EZ Worship Operator Process,"* and *"Worship Team Member Contract."* You are to complete the questionnaire, review the documents, and return the questionnaire to one of the worship team leaders. Soon after, the worship team leader will inform you of the next audition date.

Step 2.) As worship leaders we will evaluate the needs of the worship ministry and based on your questionnaire determine if there is an opening for you. We will also talk to you about your spiritual health.¹ As a ministry we recommend all our EZ Worship Operators be members of Joy Community Fellowship.

Step 3.) After evaluating the needs of the ministry, if there is an opening for you, we will schedule a time for you to be trained on our EZ Worship software. On the scheduled date of the training you will need to bring a signed copy of the *"Worship Team Member Contract."*

Step 4.) After completing steps 1-3 you will be preliminarily partnered with a seasoned EZ Worship Operator team for a period of 3 months. This probationary period is designed to determine if serving as an EZ Worship operator is a good fit for you. This requirement may be waived if there is a record of previous faithful service. It is possible that at the end of this period the worship leaders may choose not to place you with a team.

Step 5.) After successfully completing this trial period the Worship Team Member Contract will be signed by the elder overseeing the Worship Ministry and you will be placed on a worship team where you will be asked regularly to serve as an operator.
