- Available at least twice a month to be at the Welcome Tent on Sunday morning from 10-10:30am
- Some basic knowledge of American Sign Language
- An interpreter will be at the Welcome Tent to serve alongside the volunteer

- Available at least twice a month to take notes during the chosen Kindred University Class (1st Service) for that semester or during the main service in sanctuary (2nd Service).

Workshop Volunteer:

Worship Volunteer:

- Available to sit with our Deaf friends during 2nd service
- Enjoy worshiping in ASL along with the Deaf community
