## Discussion Questions

- How might God have been preparing Sarah for her life of faith?
- For what purpose was God preparing her?
- What other Scriptural evidence do we know that supports Philippians 1:6?
- How do you see Philippians 1:6 in your own life?
- What was Sarah's biggest faith challenge to God's promise of a child? In what areas has our faith been challenged?
- How does someone become a person of faith?
- What was God accomplishing in Sarah through her 25 years of barrenness? Are we comfortable waiting upon the Lord? Why?
- How does God exhibit the truth of Phil. 2:12 in these Genesis passages?
- Do we see the reality of Phil. 2:12 in our lives?
- How did Sarah respond to God's promise?
- What was Sarah's last test of faith? Is there any area of life that we are clinging to in this way?
- How did Sarah's life reveal Rom. 8:29?
