- P** The Second Commandment: You shall not misuse the name of the Lord your God.
- C** **We should fear and love God so that we guard the words of our mouth and call upon His name in trouble and in praise.**
- P** For the first things that burst forth and emerge from the heart are words. (Large Catechism)
- C** **What comes out of the mouth proceeds from the heart, and this defiles a person. (Matthew 15:18)**
