PLEASE READ BEFORE SIGNING APPLICATION

Thank you for serving the Lord and helping to advance the Kingdom of God. The following are requirements and expectations for all those serving in “Service Related” Ministries. Our purpose is to maximize effectiveness, establish Divine Order, and provide a safe and Godly environment for all who attend Light of the World Church.

MUSIC MINISTRY REQUIREMENTS

1. Must be born-again, accepting Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior.
2. Must have faithfully and consistently attended LWC for at least 6 months, confirming it as your home church by accepting the membership covenant.
3. Must have a demonstrated and consistent lifestyle of victory and freedom in Christ and not involved in substance abuse, alcohol use, smoking or issues of immorality such as co-habitation outside of marriage.
4. Must have an approved Music Ministry Application.
5. Must be skilled in your instrument/voice.
6. Must have email and access to the Internet. Music Ministry communicates through email and has its own website that displays all schedules and song sets.
7. Must attend and be on time for your assigned practices and pre-service sound checks/rehearsal.
8. Must be flexible, humble, and submissive to your worship leader and to each other.
9. Remember, we are WORSHIPPERS not performers. Be prepared with clean hands and a pure heart to worship our Savior with all of our hearts.
10. Be diligent and faithful to your schedule of service. Inform your Overseer in a timely manner when you cannot make your scheduled service (including practices), and follow their instructions. Never just “not show up”!
11. Never leave your post or assignment until worship is over or you have permission from the Worship Leader.
12. Appropriate dress: Clothes should be your best, neat and clean. Sunday: Women - knee length dress or skirt; Men- dress shirt and tie. Wednesday Evening: business casual for men and women.
13. Maintain good personal hygiene - hair well groomed, clean shaven or well trimmed beards and mustaches, no gum chewing (use mints).
14. Tattoos must be discreetly covered as much as possible. Earrings on men, as well as all other body piercing jewelry on both men and women are not allowed.
15. Be friendly, hospitable, patient, courteous and cheerful towards ministry team.
16. Concentrate on the service and those you are serving. Also, pay attention to what is happening around you.
17. Remember, you represent the Lord Jesus Christ, and Light of the World Church. We should always do our best to leave the finest impression possible and to serve Christ and His people with all our hearts.
