## Position Description: Preaching Volunteer

**Purpose:** Preaching volunteers encourage residents of Louisville Rescue Mission's LifeChange program in their relationship with God.

### Responsibilities:

- Preach a 20- to 25- minute sermon to residents of the LifeChange program.
- Reference the shared Google Document that will be made available to you to determine your specific text in the current series.
- When possible, feel welcome to stay after chapel and eat dinner with the residents.
- Maintain Christ-like relationships with staff, interns, volunteers, and residents/guests at all times.
- Keep confidential all information obtained while volunteering. This is particularly important in handling details related to residents/guests and donors.

### Qualifications:

- Be at least 18 years old
- Exceptional interpersonal, communication, and preaching skills
- Have a love for people who are homeless and hurting as well as a desire for them to be reconciled to God, their family/friends, and their community
- Be in full agreement with the Mission's core values, statement of faith, and philosophy of ministry (please see volunteer handbook)
- Be a member in good standing of a local church with like-minded beliefs
- Have past ministry and/or preaching experience (preferred, but not required)

**Time Commitment:** Preaching takes place during chapel services that are held from 5:30 to 6 p.m. each day. We strongly encourage preaching volunteers to commit to serving at least once a month, however we do occasionally have openings for one-time preaching engagements.

**Supervision:** Preaching volunteers report to the Public Relations Manager with regard to onboarding and scheduling. The LifeChange Program Manager provides all other necessary support to active preaching volunteers.
