Position Description: Thrift 'n' Thrive Volunteer

Purpose: Thrift 'n' Thrive volunteers assist store employees in managing inventory and ensuring a positive experience for both donors and customers.

Responsibilities:

- Assist in receiving and receipting donations from community donors.
- Sort, clean, and organize merchandise in the stockroom.
- Restock the sales floor.
- Help keep the interior and exterior of the building clean and organized at all times.
- Maintain Christ-like relationships with staff, interns, volunteers, residents/guests, customers, and donors at all times.
- Keep confidential all information obtained while volunteering. This is particularly important in handling details related to residents/guests and donors.

Qualifications:

- No age limit, however at least one adult must be present for every six volunteers under the age of 16
- Not exceed more than 20 people if a group
- Have a love for people who are homeless and hurting as well as a desire for them to be reconciled to God, their family/friends, and their community
- Be in full agreement with – or agree not to be divisive about – Louisville Rescue Mission's core values, statement of faith, and philosophy of ministry (please see volunteer handbook)

Time Commitment: Thrift 'n' Thrive is open weekdays from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. and Saturdays from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. Thrift 'n' Thrive volunteers can be individuals or groups, and you may sign up to volunteer as little or as often as you'd like.

Supervision: Thrift 'n' Thrive volunteers report to the Public Relations Manager with regard to onboarding and scheduling. The Store Manager and Store Assistant Manager provide all other necessary support to active Thrift 'n' Thrive volunteers.
