Key Thought: The Word is an effectual means of convincing and converting sinners.

Wednesday: Scripture: Hebrews 12:12-14; Ephesians 4:11-16

Key Thought: The Word is an effectual means of building up the saints in holiness.

Thursday: Scripture: Psalm 23:1-6; Psalm 119:47-50, 76-82; Isaiah 61:1-3

Key Thought: The Word is an effectual means of building up the saints in comfort.

Friday: Scripture: Psalm 19:7-11

Key Thought: The Word is to be treasured by God's people.
