Key Thought: In the fourth petition we seek not only our own needs but also the needs of others.

Wednesday: Scripture: Luke 12:15-31; Matthew 6:34; James 4:13-15

Key Thought: In the fourth petition we acknowledge our constant dependence upon God by faith.

Thursday: Scripture: 2 Thessalonians 3:7-12; Proverbs 4:14-17; 31:27

Key Thought: In the fourth petition we recognize our privilege and duty as stewards of God's good gifts.
