WHERE TO BEGIN?

Have you ever been in a situation where you're stumped — totally unsure what to do next?

DIGGING IN: What was the message about?

In verses 13-14, the disciples returned to Jerusalem and prayed together. When was the last time that you prayed with more than a few people? Would you do that if you had the opportunity?

In verse 20, Peter refers to Psalms. He's clearly read the Scriptures. What is your personal reading plan?

LIVE IT OUT: What do we do?

Did you hear anything helpful in the message about what you should do when you don't know what to do next?

When you find yourself struggling to take steps you already know you should take, do you often remember that the Spirit has empowered you to act?

[Family Question]: How often do we pray together as a family at a time that's not before a meal?

PRAY

Pray that God will remind us that we have the gift of the Holy Spirit to empower us to obey.
