WHERE TO BEGIN?

DIGGING IN: What was the message about?

LIVE IT OUT: What do we do?

How might you be able to help someone who is struggling to see life that way?

[Family Question]: Do we go to the Lord in prayer quickly when we encounter problems?

PRAY

Pray that God will give us safety, but even more that He would use us in His mission.
