WHERE TO BEGIN?

Have you ever been stereotyped by where you're from, a school you attended or anything else?

DIGGING IN: What was the message about?

One noble characteristic a church should be known for is encouraging steadfast faithfulness, such as Barnabas exhibited. Do you ever feel discouraged in serving? Has anyone ever been an encourager to you?

LIVE IT OUT: What do we do?

Another noble characteristic is a willingness to share Jesus with anyone and everyone. Is there someone in your neighborhood or work who is just so different from you that it's difficult to imagine sharing with them?

Churches also should empower future leaders. Are you willing to be empowered either to serve or to lead? What are the limits to your willingness?
