WHERE TO BEGIN?

Did you ever visit a place where you needed a guide? (Or wished you had a guide?)

DIGGING IN: What was the message about?

Has God ever taken you to a place or person where you wouldn't have gone yourself?

It's important to ask people questions — can you think of a good question to ask a friend or neighbor who you are spending time with?

LIVE IT OUT: What do we do?

Are you running toward the opportunities that God presents to you? Are there any in which you've delayed?

What do you need in order to become a better guide to the lost? How can you get it?

[Family Question]: Are there ways we could be better guides to those we know?

PRAY

Pray that we would follow the Spirit's promptings about reaching the lost.

Sermon Points

1. A good guide learns to listen for the Spirit's prompting.
2. A good guide learns to obey the promptings the Spirit gives.
3. A good guide learns to join God — He is already at work!

5. A good guide learns to take time to sit with people, listen and let their questions stir the discussion.
6. A good guide learns to use the Scriptures to share the Good News about Jesus.
