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3. What do verses 4-6 reveal about the unity and diversity of spiritual gifts?
4. What might make some partners of our church feel useless or envious of other parts of the body (vv. 12-26)?
5. According to Paul, how can we make every part of the body feel special (vv. 21-26)?
6. Paul does not give us a complete list of gifts in this chapter. What might the words first, second, third and then (v.28) indicate?

8. What can you do to help others in your group or church to discover their giftedness?
9. How would you like to develop and exercise your spiritual gifts?
