Natalie Sisters is a local ministry we support through our missions budget. Learn more at nataliessisters.org

During 2018, Natalie's Sisters:

- ⇒ distributed 4,143 meals to its Sisters; did 214 jail and hospital visits; served 2388 clients at its drop-in center; and 49% of its referrals are made to addiction recovery treatment centers.
- ⇒ 52 churches/church groups prayed, collected clothing and toiletries, cared for the yard/facility, wrote letters and cards of encouragement, provided meals, donated financially, and mobilized volunteers to serve in all aspects of the ministry.
- ⇒ many survivors were baptized and are actively attending services at churches
- ⇒ Sisters are receiving more critical medical care, professional therapy, case management and support services
