WESTMINSTER SHORTER CATECHISM

Q. 50

Q. What is required in the second commandment?

A. The second commandment requires the receiving, observing, and keeping pure and entire, all such religious worship and ordinances as God has appointed in His word.

\*Heidelberg Catechism Q. 44: "Why is there added, 'He descended into hell?' A. That in my greatest temptations I may be assured, and wholly comfort myself with this, that my Lord Jesus Christ, by His inexpressible anguish, pains, terrors, and hellish agony in which He was plunged during all His sufferings, but especially on the cross, has delivered me from the anguish and torment of hell." We do not believe that Jesus actually went to Hell-only that He endured eternal punishment as an eternal being on the cross under the eternal wrath of God.

\*\*Heidelberg Catechism Q. 54: "What do you believe concerning 'the holy catholic church'? A. I believe that the Son of God through His Spirit and Word, out of the entire human race, from the beginning of the world to its end, gathers, protects, and preserves for himself a community chosen for eternal life and united in true faith. And of this community I am and always will be a living member." We do not mean what "the Roman Catholic Church" means by their use of the phrase catholic. "Catholic" merely means "Universal."
