

NORTH BIBLE CHURCH MAN WEEKEND DETAILS

DATES: Arrive on Friday May 4th between 5:30 and 7:00 p.m., (eat dinner before you arrive), our 1st session will begin at 7:30. There are plenty of places to grab dinner in Payson. You are welcome to arrive any time after 2:30 but we will probably put you to work. We will head home after lunch on Sunday May 6th at around 12:30 p.m..

LOCATION: Mountain Meadows Ranch is located in Christopher Creek AZ. MMR is a 70 acre ranch about 90 miles from Scottsdale. The elevation is about 6000 feet and the temperature in May ranges from a high of 80 and an overnight low of 50.

DIRECTIONS: Take Highway 87 (Beeline Highway) to Payson. Take Route 260 East approximately 20 miles to the Christopher Creek turn off and take a left. In about a mile take a left on the dirt road just past the Creekside Steakhouse. Follow the MMR signs about a mile to the MMR camp and park at the end of the road in the parking area by the dining hall.

LODGING: We will be staying in rustic cabins with bunk beds and there is a building with bathrooms and showers.

ACTIVITIES: **Shooting** – We will be bringing targets, guns, ammo and clays and you are welcome to bring your own equipment. (guns and ammo stay in your vehicle it's time to shoot). **Fishing** – Christopher Creek flows through the property so you are welcome to bring a fishing rod and you will need a valid fishing license. **Archery** – We will be bringing targets, bows and arrows but you are welcome to bring your own equipment. **Hiking** - Lots of great trails so bring your hiking shoes/boots.

MEALS: All meals, snacks and drinks will be provided. Reminder, no dinner will be provided on Friday night and we end with lunch on Sunday. If you have special dietary needs please don't hesitate to call Wes for menu details.

WHAT TO BRING:

Everyone needs to bring - Bible - Sleeping bag – Pillow – Towel – Toiletries – Camp Chair – Earplugs - Flashlight - Jacket

Optional items - Fishing equipment (license) – Archery/Shooting equipment – Whatever else you can think of as long as it is legal.
