
How do I receive help?

STEP 1

If you are applying for need-based assistance, complete the WCS on-line Tuition Assistance Application (cts-tuition.com/app/whiwhima/). The deadline for this application is March 31. Contact WCS for more info about this process. If you are not applying for need-based aid, skip this step.

STEP 2

Complete the PSCRC Christian Education Assistance Application and return it to your pastorate deacon by April 15.

STEP 3

After receiving your Christian Education Assistance Application, it will be reviewed. Your pastorate elder or deacon will contact you if there are any questions. If you marked on your application that you applied for tuition assistance through WCS, the deacons will receive the results directly from the school financial office. This is used to determine financial need.

STEP 4

Aid will be distributed based on available funds, number of families applying for assistance, and financial need. Payment will be made directly to the school. Families will be notified by July 1.

We know that Christian education is expensive. We know it can be a barrier for parents who want to place their children in a Christian school but simply cannot to afford it.

We are here to help! The council has partnered with Whitinsville Christian School to make financial aid available to families with children in grades K-12. There are two options for participating in this program.

1. *Need-based* Tuition Assistance Program in which aid is provided using a recommended formula set up by WCS
2. *Non need-based* Christian Education Assistance that is available to church members whose children attend WCS.



Who qualifies? Parents who are members of Pleasant Street CRC and are actively involved in the mission of the church. This is defined as:

- Regularly attending worship.
- Actively participating in ministry.
- Joyfully giving of their time, talents, and treasures to the Kingdom work of PSCRC.
