Scripture: Genesis 3:6, 12, 13.

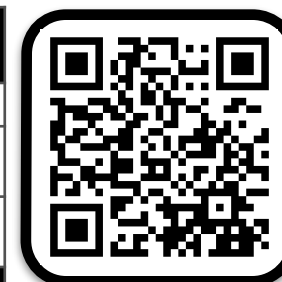
Question 20: Did all mankind fall in Adam's first sin?
