8. How does the Perspicuity (clarity) of Scripture bring us confidence in our Christian life? Examples?
9. In your own words, explain the doctrine of the sufficiency of Scripture? Why is the sufficiency of Scripture important? What are some ways that you see the sufficiency of Scripture being attacked in the world and even in some churches?
10. What are the four ways we profit from Scripture according to 2 Timothy 3:16-17? What are some recent examples in your life where the Scriptures were profitable in each of these four areas?
11. What should be the ultimate result of the Scriptures in your Spiritual life? (Follow up question: What are some practical steps that you have undertaken to grow toward maturity spiritually?)
