All: Limitless God, too often we think you are like us — finite and failing. We confess that we too often limit you in our thoughts, words and deeds. We sinfully compare you to ourselves. We think you are limited in your power over difficulties in our lives, in your control over the unpredictability of the world, and in your ability to walk with us in broken, dark places. In public we praise you as the infinite God, but in private we fail to mention you during the remainder of the week. When we reach the end of our own strength, instead of seeking you whose strength is endless, we complain against you and try all the more to do things in our own power. Father, thank you that you are limitless in your love and mercy to us! Remind us again that the infinite God became a man in the person Jesus Christ to rescue us from the curse and restore us to you through the work of the Spirit.
