NEW NURSERY PROCEDURES: The safety of our covenant children is one of the highest priorities of the SPC nursery. NORTON PARK: Norton Park Elementary is an at-risk school in our community, where 99% of students qualify for Free/Reduced Lunch due to family economic hardship. When school is out of session, for various breaks, many of these children go without food. SPC has committed to filling the pantry at Norton Park so that these children are fed during these times. Our next shopping date to fill the pantry will be **February 7th and we need your help! To fully stock the pantry, it takes from \$1,500.00 to \$2,000.00. Thus far we have collected \$985.00.** This is not a line item in the SPC budget, but rather a faith-based giving opportunity. To ensure that students have food through the break, we need to come together as a church to raise the funds needed for the students at Norton Park. Any amount you can give will make a difference in the lives of these children in our community. Thank you so much for your support.
