Fall - Semester 1 Verses September 16 - December 16

PSALM 1

- *1 Blessed is the one who does not walk in step with the wicked or stand in the way that sinners take or sit in the company of mockers,
- *2 but whose delight is in the law of the Lord, and who meditates on his law day and night.
- *3 That person is like a tree planted by streams of water, which yields its fruit in season and whose leaf does not wither—whatever they do prospers.
- *4 Not so the wicked! They are like chaff that the wind blows away.
- *5 Therefore the wicked will not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the assembly of the righteous.
- *6 For the Lord watches over the way of the righteous, but the way of the wicked leads to destruction.

3rd-5th grades add these:

Matthew 22:37-39

- 37 Jesus replied: Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.
- 38 This is the first and greatest commandment.
- 39 And the second is like it: Love your neighbor as yourself.

2nd Semester Verses

January 27 - May 12

ARMOR OF GOD Ephesians 6:13-17

- *13 Therefore put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand.
- *14 Stand firm then, with the belt of truth buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place,
- *15 and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace.
- *16 In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one.
- *17 Take up the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.

***Romans 3:23**

For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.

***Romans 5:8**

But God demonstrates His own love for us in this: While we were sinners, Christ died for us.
