

# **SUMMER SCHOOL REGISTRATION**



**JUNE 4-29, 2018**

**OPEN TO ST. JOHN'S STUDENTS  
ENTERING GRADES 1-8**

St. John's Summer School is for St. John's students entering 1<sup>st</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> grade. The goal of St. John's Summer School is to offer an engaging learning environment for students to continue developing skills in a variety of subject areas. Classes offer a reduced class size and Christ-centered setting.

### **Hours of Operation**

Summer School is offered in one week sessions from June 4<sup>th</sup>-29<sup>th</sup>. Each week offers two time blocks. The first block is from 8:30 AM-10:00 AM. The second block is from 10:30 AM-12:00 PM. If a student is staying for both blocks, there is a 30 minute break from 10:00 AM-10:30 AM. During this break, the students will be supervised for recess/snack time. Students are to provide their own snack.

### **Registration/Fees/Programs**

All forms, along with a \$50 non-refundable registration fee, all class fees, and all extended care fees are due at the time of registration. The registration deadline is April 27, 2018.

Each individual class costs \$75 per child. Registration is not complete until all fees are received. No forms are accepted without all fees. Each class must have a minimum of 5 students registered to be held. If this minimum is not met by the registration deadline, parents will be notified and receive a refund for that class.

Extended Care is available each day from 12:00 PM-6:00 PM. Summer Extended Care is only offered to those students attending Summer School classes. The fee for Extended Care is \$75 per week. Extended Care closes promptly at 6:00 PM. A late fee of \$5.00 per child is assessed for the first five minutes after 6:00 PM, with an additional \$1.00 per minute for every minute after 6:05 PM. Late parents will be billed late fees. This policy is strictly enforced.

### **Clothing**

Uniforms are not required, but clothing must follow the guidelines as per the 2017-2018 Student & Parent Handbook. As taken from p. 23, *clothing must be appropriate to school activities and must be neatly hemmed. The following are not allowed: sleeveless shirts for boys, "spaghetti straps;" tank tops with straps narrower than two fingers width, clothing with holes, tears, rips, or frays; shorts, skirts, or dresses shorter than halfway between the mid-thigh and the knee; shirts with questionable sayings; leggings, jeggings, exercise pants, yoga pants, tight-fitting pants, etc. unless worn with a shirt or top that covers to mid-thigh; tight-fitting shorts or tops; or any other apparel deemed inappropriate by the Administration. At no time should undergarments or the midriff area be exposed. For safety reasons, shoes should be closed-toe and -heel and should fit and be fastened in such a way that they do not come off easily. Shoes should have a flat sole with a heel height of no more than ½ inch. No wheeled shoes are allowed at any time.*

### **Illness**

Children who are ill are not permitted to attend summer school. Children with fever or diarrhea are not permitted in summer school. All children must be fever-free and diarrhea-free for a 24-hour period before returning.

### **Behavior**

All students are expected to comply with all the guidelines and rules of behavior as explained in the Student & Parent Handbook. Student's behavior is to be respectful and appropriate toward the teachers and other students. If behavior problems arise, parents will be notified.

### **Sign-In/Sign Out**

Students who access Extended Care must be signed in and signed out by the guardian adult at that time. Students may never, under any circumstances, sign themselves in or out of Extended Care.
