Treasuring Jesus: The Life of a Disciple Built on The Rock

Text: Luke 6.39-39

Looking into the Text:

- 1. What is a cultural myth that Jesus strikes down in 6.43-45? What is the truth about people's condition and the solution to their problem (Ezekiel 36.26; 2 Corinthians 5.17)?
- 2. If Jesus is truly Lord what will be present in the disciple's life (6.46-49)? What could the 'rock' foundation be (1 Peter 2.6; Acts 20.32; James 1.22)?
- 3. What is the relationship that Jesus is calling us to look like (6.39-40)? What is a disciple? Who are we to be trained by? What is the goal of the disciple (Colossians 3.16; 2 Corinthians 3.18; Hebrews 6.1; Philippians 3.8-14)?
- 4. What is our relationship with others to look like (6.41-42)? How important is our own holiness according to Jesus? Do we ever confront someone about their sin and how when we do (Galatians 6.1; Luke 6.37)?

Looking Deeper:

- 1. What are you truly building your life upon? Is it built on the truth of God and obedience to it? If not, is the issue God's truth or is it an obedience issue? What in your life right now do you need to act on and obey?
- 2. How is your relationship with Jesus like a student/teacher relationship that Jesus speaks of in 6.40?

PRAY:

- 1. Pray for the group that we would walk in obedience to the truth of God.
- 2. Pray that our church body that we would be a learning, loving and obedient people.

Do: Think through what you need to be specifically obedient to this week and act upon it. Let someone in your group know and to keep you accountable this week. Maybe it is being obedient to share the gospel with someone this week.
