Treasuring Jesus: Take The Handoff and Run

Text: Luke 9.1-17

Looking into the Text:

1. When Jesus calls the twelve disciples together what does He give them (9.1)? Why do they need what He gives? Once He equips them what is their mission (9.2)?
2. Why does Jesus send them on this short journey with instructions to take little with them (9.3-5)? What does He want from them (Matthew 6.25-33)?
3. Jesus gives them instructions, but what is significant about 9.6?
4. What is the context of ministry that the disciples were to minister in (9.7-9)? What did people think about Jesus?
5. When the disciples come back and are with Jesus what do we learn is important to ministry as well (9.10)?
6. Why is it important that Jesus provides this meal for the crowd? What does it show us about who Jesus is?

Looking Deeper:

1. What is our mission that Jesus has called us to (2 Corinthians 5.17-20; Matthew 28.18-20)? Instead of self what has Jesus called us to focus on (Philippians 2.3-4)?
2. How are you living out a sent life like the disciples? Is the context we live in and are called to any different than the one the disciples were called to? Discuss.
3. How have you seen Jesus provide for your needs? Do you think you can trust Jesus to provide for your needs currently?

PRAY:

1. Pray for the group that we would live a life of obedience and be willing to go as the disciples did.
2. Pray that our church body would be continually active in ministry daily proclaiming the gospel.

Do: Pray and ask the Lord to give you a life that is focused on ministry to others. Then take opportunities this week to speak about Jesus and the gospel to others as you go about your days. Trust the Lord as you do to empower you and give you all that you need for the mission
