5. What does Paul share with the Jews on the day they meet? What is the difference between the gospel and the ladder mentality (Romans 1.16; 2 Corinthians 5.21; Ephesians 2.8-9)?
6. What was the response of the Jews from the day long gathering? How is the gospel divisive? What was the point of Paul's parting words from their gathering?
7. What did Paul do for the next two years in Rome? Acts ends, but the story continues with who? What is the challenge for us from the book of Acts that we are to carry on from what the apostles and Paul begin?
