LIFEgroup Discussion Questions

February 7, 2016

Text: Acts 2.14-39

1. What are the three questions we asked from the sermon (2.12, 37)? Two are asked for us by the crowd and then one we asked based on the text (Who is the Lord who saves?).
2. When Peter answers the first question he does so by defending those 120 Spirit-filled believers by saying that *what is not* happening? Then he answers *what is* happening by referring to whose prophetic message? What does Peter say is happening with referring to Joel 2 (2.17-21)?
3. With the reference to whom the Spirit falls on what is the picture we see of whom God is saving? What is so beautiful about it?
4. What is the significance of Peter of referring to “last days” from Joel’s prophecy (2.17; Hebrews 1.1-2)?
5. In 2.17-18, 21 you have the powerful witness of the church, but what are the days described as in 2.19-20?
6. As Jesus declares that Jesus is the Lord who saves, what four things does He speak of to endorse Jesus as Lord (2.22-35)? How do we see the proclamation of Jesus as the work of the Holy Spirit specifically (John 15.26-27)? Jesus’ death was part of God’s eternal plan, but what is significant about what Peter says about who “nailed Jesus to the cross”.
7. How do the words of David that Peter uses for Psalm 16 speak to our experience with the effects of being saved by the death and resurrection of Jesus (2.25-28)?
8. How does Peter answer the last question of the crowd, *What shall we do* (2.37)? What does *repent* mean?
