2. What does James want us to know, as he says in James 1.19, *know this*? Look back at 1.17-18 to help answer that and then remember that we are to live in harmony with these important truths found there. Why do we sometimes forget our true identity?

4. What are we to get rid of (1.21)? How are we to receive the Word of God? What is the saving work of the implanted word and how does it continue to save us?
5. What is a mere hearer versus a doer of the Word of God (1.22-24)? What is significant for the believer to do in regards to the Word of God being like a mirror? What does 1 John 3.10 say about the biblical line between a disciple of Jesus and one who is not?
6. Instead of forgetting how are we to approach and come before the Word of God (1.25)? What does the terms perfect law and the law of liberty speak of when it comes to the Word of God?
7. According to 1.26-27, what is the work that the effectual doer does? What is true worship (Isaiah 1.13-17)?
